Submissions are subject to a rigorous, single-blinded peer review by at least two of our journal's more than thirty members of the editorial board. During this efficient two-week process, authors will be able to check the progress of their contributions through the journal's website.

Once the article has been published, SAGE Publications will immediately make it freely accessible online, where everybody can make use of it. Our journal is published open access with authors still retaining their copyright. There are no subscription pay-walls because it is our objective to make vital research open to everybody.

Our Federation

The mission of the SFCNS (founded in 2009) is to promote collaborations and interactions between clinical neuro-societies in Switzerland in order to enhance interdisciplinary knowledge and overall impact of our disciplines at a medical, scientific, public and political level.
